



Dillwynia phyllicoides

Small-leaf Parrot Pea

Height:	0.5m - 1.5m
Width:	1m - 2m
Habit:	Spreading to erect shrub.
Foliage:	Small narrow twisted leaves to 1cm long.
Flowers:	Clusters of yellow and red pea flowers from September to December.
Requirements:	Well drained drier soils. Partial sun.
Cultivation & uses:	A very hardy and ornamental species. An attractive garden addition for lightly shaded areas. Effective in mass plantings. Responds well to hard pruning. Tolerates frost.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is unknown.

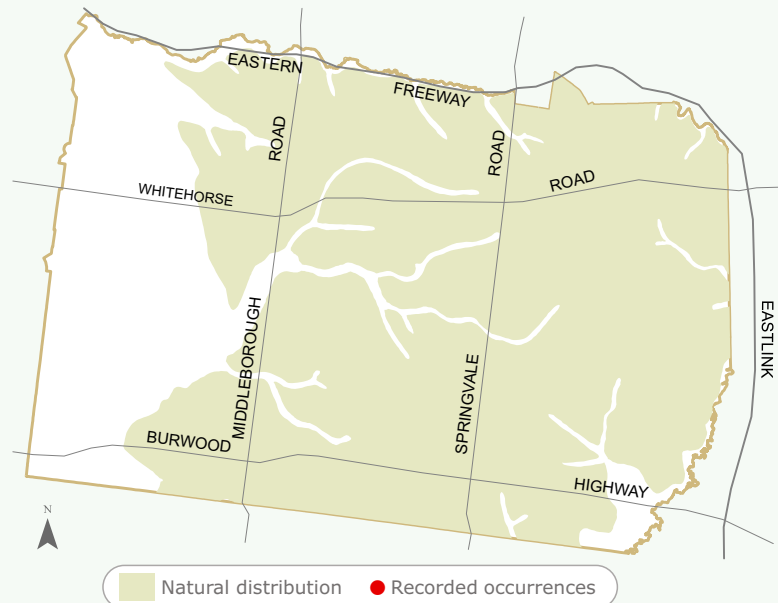
