

Goodenia ovata Hop Goodenia

Height:

1m - 2.5m

Width:

1m - 3m

Habit:

Small to medium open to straggling shrub.

Foliage:

Light green oval shaped toothed leaves to 10cm long.

Flowers:

Small spays of bright yellow flowers, open and well displayed. Flowers from August to February.

Requirements:

Adaptable to most soils. Shade, full or partial sun.

Cultivation & uses:


Provides a natural element to a bush garden. Pruning will avoid the plant from becoming straggly. Can be planted beneath established trees. Hardy, will tolerate periods of waterlogging.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is moderate.
