



# *Goodia lotifolia*

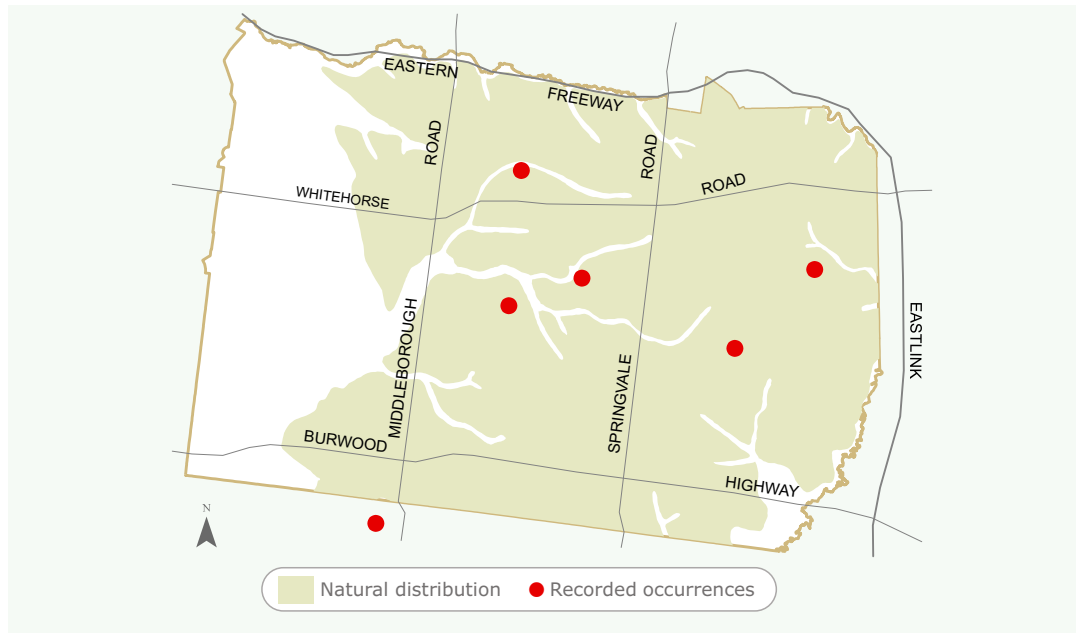
## Golden Tip, Clover Tree

<b>Height:</b>	1m - 5m
<b>Width:</b>	1m - 5m
<b>Habit:</b>	Fast-growing medium to large open erect shrub.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Bluish-green oval shaped leaves composed of 3 clover-like leaflets to 25mm long.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Profuse sprays of large fragrant yellow pea flowers with reddish markings. Flowers from September to December.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Well drained soils. Full or partial sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	A hardy plant, very showy in flower. Prune after flowering to maintain a bushy growth. Useful as a quick screen or may be trimmed to form a tall, loose hedge.

### Local Distribution:

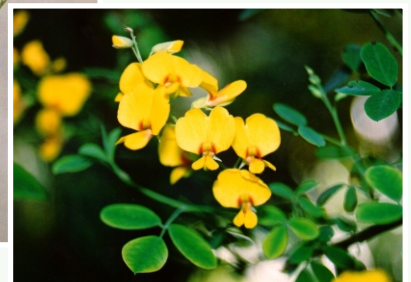
Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.
