



Helichrysum scorpioides

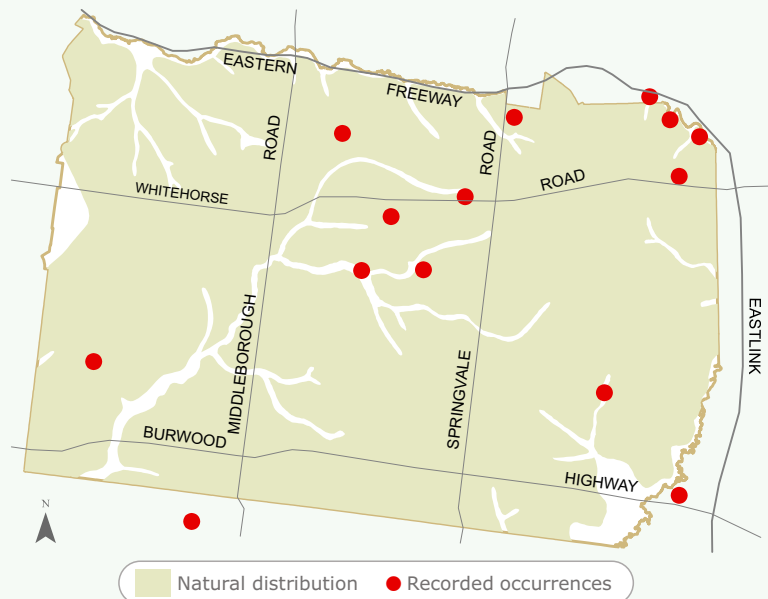
Button Everlasting, Curling Everlasting

Height:	30cm
Width:	20cm - 30cm
Habit:	A dense mat-forming perennial herb spreading by underground stems.
Foliage:	Clump of broad, soft, velvety grey-green basal leaves to 7cm long.
Flowers:	Single flat yellow flowers 2-3cm wide, surrounded by brown-yellow papery bracts like a daisy flower, held on long erect stems to 30cm. Flowers from September to December.
Requirements:	Well drained soils, preferring dry sites. Full or partial sun.
Cultivation & uses:	An attractive matting plant with a showy floral display, ideal for cottage gardens, rockeries or borders. Foliage dies back each year after flowering. Flowers dry well if picked young.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is moderate.
