



# *Hibbertia obtusifolia*

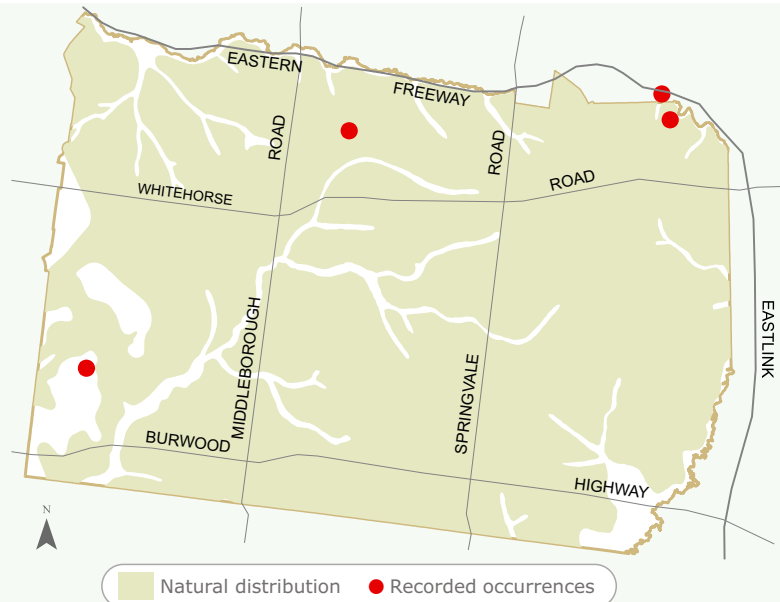
## Showy Guinea-flower, Grey Guinea-flower

<b>Height:</b>	30cm - 60cm
<b>Width:</b>	1m
<b>Habit:</b>	A small open rounded to spreading shrub.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Hairy broad to rounded grey-green leaves to 2cm long.
<b>Flowers:</b>	Masses of large bright yellow flowers from August to February.
<b>Requirements:</b>	Well drained soils, tolerating dry shade once established. Partial sun.
<b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b>	An attractive plant, very showy in flower. A good ornamental plant for rockeries, containers and cottage gardens. May be established beneath established trees.

### Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is rare.
