



# *Juncus procerus*

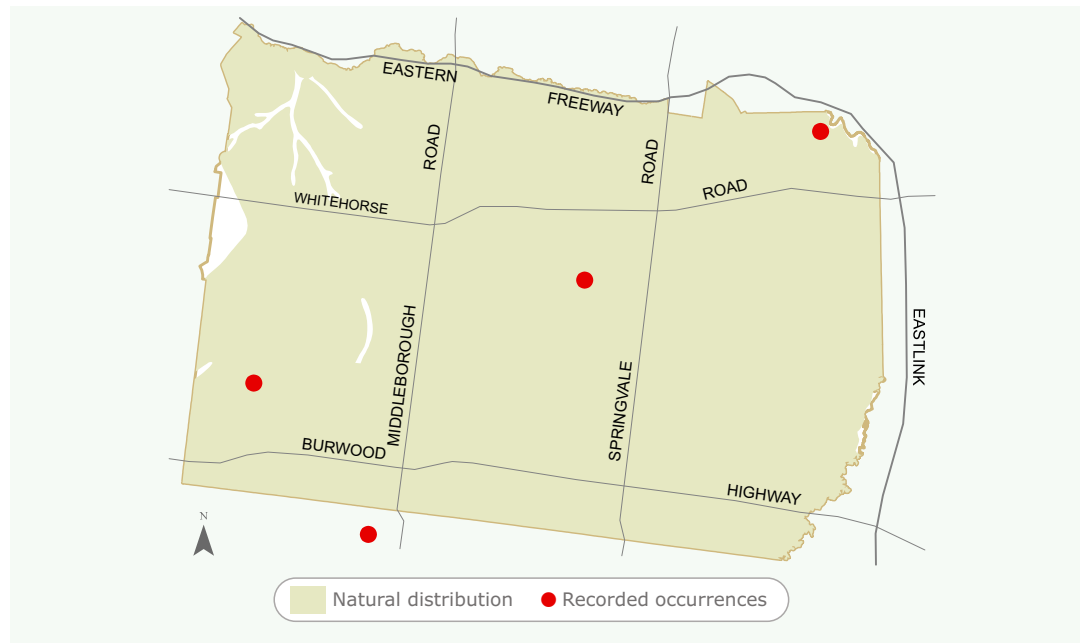
## Tall Rush

| <b>Height:</b>                 | 1m - 2m   |
| <b>Width:</b>                  | 0.6m - 1.5m   |
| <b>Habit:</b>                  | Tufted perennial rush spreading from underground stems.   |
| <b>Foliage:</b>                | Soft, thick, dull to light green stems with large, broad, brown sheath-like leaves to 15cm long loosely surrounding the stem. |
| <b>Flowers:</b>                | Compact brown flowerheads on erect stems from October to February.  |
| <b>Requirements:</b>           | Moist, well drained soils in sheltered positions. Partial sun.  |
| <b>Cultivation &amp; uses:</b> | Suited for plantings beside water areas.  |

### Local Distribution:
