



Schoenoplectus validus

River Club Rush

Height:	1.5m - 2m
Width:	1.5m - 3m
Habit:	Tall robust tufted perennial herb.
Foliage:	Fine blue-green needle-like leaves.
Flowers:	Loose umbel-like brown flowerheads on erect stems from November to April.
Requirements:	Wet soils. Full or partial sun.
Cultivation & uses:	An attractive rush, useful for creating an architectural effect around water edges. Most suited to swamps and wetlands. Useful for erosion control.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is rare.

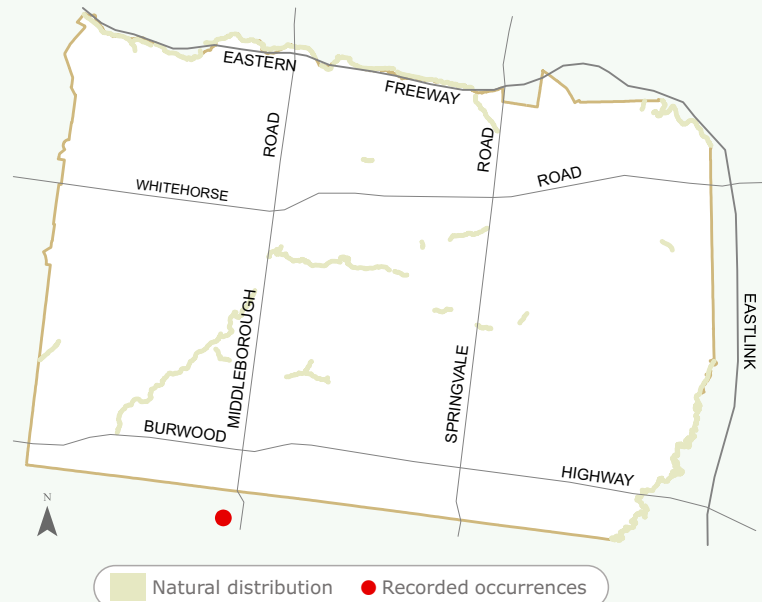
