



Vittadinia muelleri

Narrow Leaf New Holland Daisy

Height:	10cm - 30cm
Width:	30cm
Habit:	Perennial herb with woody rootstock and erect tufted stems branching from the base.
Foliage:	Narrow to elliptical leaves to 45mm long.
Flowers:	Dark blue daisy-like flowers with yellow centres held on stalks much longer than the foliage from most of the year. The fruit is small up to 5mm long.
Requirements:	Full or partial sun. Tolerates dry conditions.
Cultivation & uses:	Perennial daisy of grasslands.

Local Distribution:

Map is indicative to the natural distribution of the species based on the best available knowledge.

The natural occurrence of this species is rare.
